Delivery of first direct project

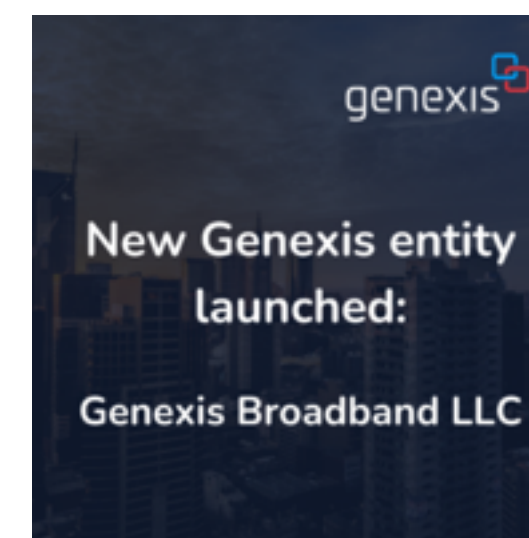

Genexis already has a market-leading position in Europe for independent Optical Network Termination products and is committed to providing easy-to-install, fully interoperable, and future-proof solutions for PON and Active Ethernet.
